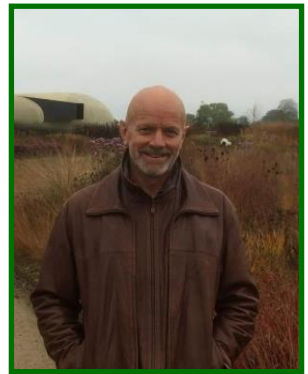

Store cattle in short supply but extremely high demand again this week. All grades and breeds look very well sold again today with plenty of buyers and fierce competition. More numbers expected in the coming weeks as cattle are being TB tested.

SUCKLER COWS

An excellent consignment of Saler x suckler cows with 5mo calves at foot from Nick Painter which saw many sets over £1300 and 3 times over £1700 to peak at £1850.

ORGANIC

Only a few Organic as not our special monthly sale, but all those forward saw a brilliant trade throughout. Superb Charolais older steers from Aldenham Farms topped at an amazing £1670, 1570 and £1275. Hard Angus Dairy bred steers to £1090 from Steve Pomeroy.

YOUNG CONTINENTAL

Well, demand continuing to be at the highest levels for all younger cattle. As the finished Beef remains to be in strong demand the knock-on effect is plain to see. Wonderful hard quality 7mo Charolais from regular vendor Will Stitch saw steers at £915 and heifers at £902. This sale saw our annual consignment of 50 Blonde x steers and heifers from Alan Pike & family. These quality well presented cattle were keenly sought by all. Best bunches of steers 10mo were at £1040, £1000 and £980. Their heifers always over £800 topping at £885.
