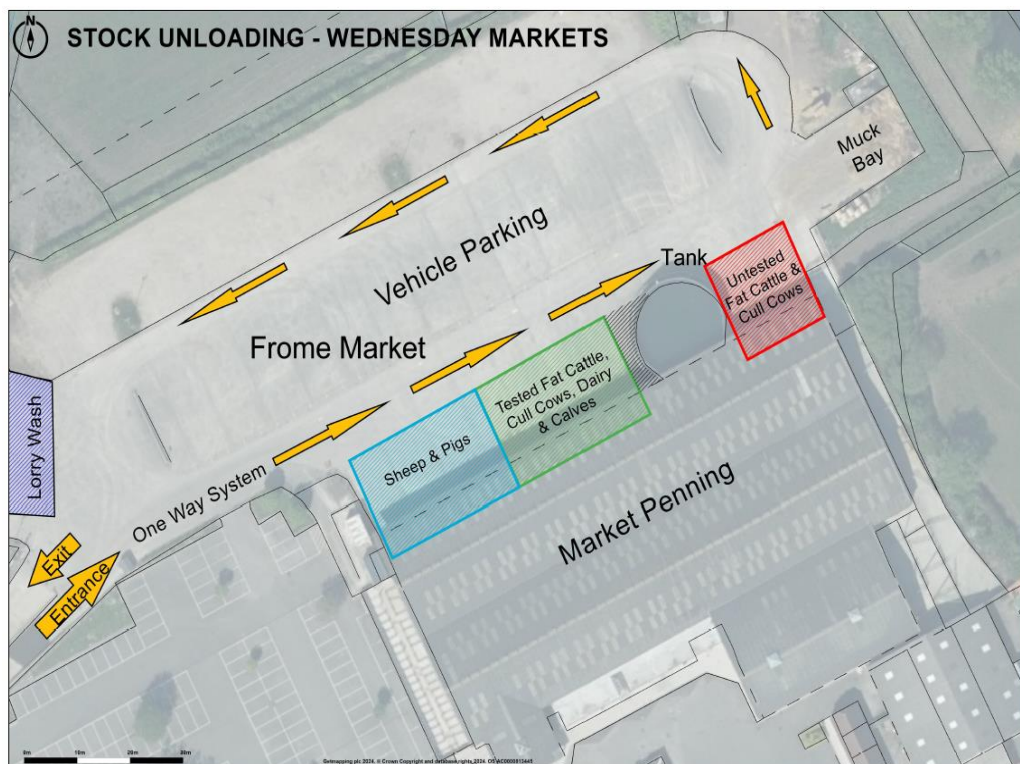

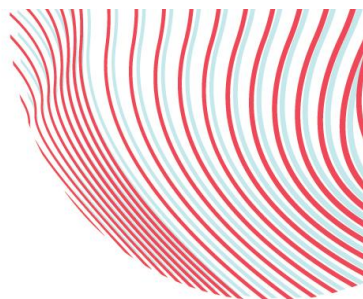

Another very strong trade at Frome this week.

SUCKLER COWS & CALVES

Cows & calves saw competitive bidding and those forward mainly had calves under a month old. Leaner types from West Amesbury Farm saw Angus 8 y/o cows and 10 day heifer calf to £1130 and 5y/o Hereford with 15 days heifer calf to £1040.

FEEDING BULLS

A very bright trade for all feeding bulls today. Super British Shorthorn 7mo bulls to £825 from ME Christian, older plainer Herefords from £812 to £880.

ORGANIC

Just a few Organics forward but all found keen demand and were well sold. Smart young suckled Angus 10mo topped at £945. Older, leaner Angus heifers and Herefords were in demand by the finishing men and generally over £1000.

YOUNG CONTINENTAL

Not too many single suckled younger types forward this week but those on offer created a tremendously strong trade. A super entry from PR & JR Best 11-12mo saw their top quality Blonde x steers & heifers all over £1100. All heifers over £900 with top pen to £1060. David & Liz Brimble continuing to present best grade Charolais 14mo steers to £1260 and heifers to £1095. Well fed Dairy Continentals with shape were well sold which saw PE King (Bristol) Ltd 12mo steers to £1100 and 14mo heifers to £1160. A good consignment of 40 Blue x 13-14mo from L & H Coombes were wanted regularly from £950 - £1080. Quality Simmental x home bred Dairy x from Merryfield Farmers often £950 - £1050 and topped at £1082. Overall, despite the weather demand still at top levels.

ANGUS & HEREFORD

No problem to sell the traditional Angus and all that were presented were very well sold throughout the day. Young quality suckled Angus x South Devon steers from Richard Hopkins 10mo topped at £1065 with heifers at £900. Younger dairy x wanted seeing good numbers 10-12mo £800- £900. A grand consignment from L & H Coombes of dairy bred younger Angus generally £850 - £950 and were wanted. A wonderful show today of older more forward cattle and all consignments created a tremendous trade. A truly wonderful consignment of 20-22mo Angus from Roger Glover saw the fiercest of bidding with best -pens of steers well over £1600 peaking at £1665. Heifers were equally sought at £1250 - £1495. Rather like the other traditional breeds Hereford cattle were all at high levels, however, not the numbers of big forward stores available this week. Smith's of Westbury topped the steers at £1290 closely followed by Keith Isgar to £1245. Older heifers generally £950 - £1080 but no heavy flesh sorts available. Bulling demand just beginning to start and while buyers selective were well prepared to pay for the right types.

Very few Friesian forward and generally a "mixed bag" with very plain leaner extreme Holstein steers £800 - £1000, while stronger more Friesian types had a lively trade throughout. Buyers keen for 'warm' fleshed sorts with grand steers from Hollands Farms (Blandford) and D & PR Tibbs & Son at £1410, £1350 and John Jackson to £1245.

FORWARD CONTINENTAL

Some good consignments of middle-aged Continentals 17-18mo with a particularly strong entry from H Visser & A Gessey of Blue x Dairy bred steers and heifers. Many over £1150 and best pens at £1205 and £1250, heifers £1000 - £1090. More forward 23mo Blue steers from FJ Burfitt topped at £1345. Super strong boned Charolais from RJ Glover blasted up to £1540 with ease. Simmental 24mo heifers from the same home settled at £1380. Overall another top day at Frome. Thank you to all for your support.
