



An absolute flyer at Frome today with trade as dear as ever despite the weather and lessening finished Beef price. Some super consignments of quality suckler bred cattle with shape and potential entered for the show potential sale attracting buyers from North, South, East & West. Forward feeding cattle still a straight price.

FEEDING BULLS

Only a few forward but good demand throughout and 9mo Herefords to a strong £825.

GRAZING/FEEDING COWS

Excellent prices for the cows with Angus x to £1190.

YOUNG CONTINENTAL

What a day in this section with some super quality included both in the commercial and potential show sections. Too many grand types to mention all vendors but trade was electric with buyers really wanting cattle to turnout as the warmer weather arrives. This sale saw our annual consignment of 50 single suckled home bred Limousin from Nick Bond. Demand for these super commercial well conformed cattle was excellent. Their 6-9mo steers regularly over £1100 and often £1200 topping at £1275. Heifers equally sought from £850 - £950 topping at £1050. The icing on the cake was a quite outstanding consignment of Blue & Limousin (10-11mo) from A & A Gale. All had excellent confirmation which produced ferocious bidding regularly £1200+ and the best to £1340, £1430 and £1500!! Heifers from the same home always over £1000 and peaked at £1078. Virtually all the Young Continentals £800 - £1000 this week and more could have been sold as more purchasers come to Frome.

FRIESIAN

A pair of Friesian steers topped at £1200 from RC Garraway. Younger steers from Bown & Son to £1095 and £1090 from JC Gay & Son. Younger Fleckvieh steers to £750 at 11mo.

ANGUS & HEREFORD

Angus steers from RC Garraway topped at £1710 for a pair at 28mo. Similar quality from JG Trott to £1670 and £1395 from RDR Stevens. A cracking consignment of well grown Angus steers & heifers saw steers to £1375 for a pen of 7 and heifers to £1280 for pen of 6. Heifers from Bown & Son to £1230 for 16mo and steers from PW King to £1290 for the same age. Younger steers again from Bown & Son to £1090 for 14mo. Younger farming steers to £890 for 9mo from PW King. Hard outlying steers to £800 for 12-14mo from LH Coombes and others to £765. The traditional Herefords continuing to be wanted and I felt were generally met with keener interest than perhaps in recent sales. 9mo steers £800 - £900 and heifers £600 - £700. An excellent entry from DJ & EJ Mitchell saw their best 9mo steer to an amazing £1000 and their heifer to £750. More forward Herefords easily sold with some wonderful thick steers from Richard & Londeen Garraway to £1565. Big boned types from Morris Emery & family to £1250. Bulling heifers just beginning to create interest £900 - £1000. Overall another strong day in this section.
