FORWARD CONTINENTAL



Fleshed types met a premium with young forward steers selling to £1430 (only 21mo) for a pen of 5 British Blue steers from R C Few & Son of Longbridge Deverill and their Blue heifers also keenly sought to £1300 (21mo). Younger, well reared Blue heifers also met a fast trade to £1195 (16mo) from PE King Ltd of Bristol and £1190 (19mo) from Pinniger & Sons of Calne.
