

A good run of Friesian cows with good cover sold to 189p/kg and £1221 and others to 188p/kg, 186p/kg, 171p/kg and 175p/kg, averaging 181p/kg. More prime cattle and cull cows wanted for the next sale.

STORES

A very strong entry of cattle for our May sale of TB restricted animals. Trade very firm throughout although the fleshed types (as in our Friday sales) just seeing demand reflecting the easier finished slaughter prices. A number of nice types available with most breeds represented. Buyers continuing to travel considerable distances to support the Orange market.

CONTINENTAL
