

A well-supported Dairy section produced a wonderfully buoyant trade. Still a shortage of fresh milk but those on offer had a super trade. Top home bred Friesian Holstein calved heifers from Pennard Farms to £1970, £1880 and £1800. This sale saw the final entry of 24 in-calf Friesian Holstein & Jersey x cows and heifers from Reads Farm Partnership, Isle of Wight. These super types saw many returning clients (having previous purchased) keen to buy and all produced a lively trade averaging £1320. June/August calving Friesian/Holstein heifers £1280 - £1410. A strong Bath & West Show week entry produced a tremendously strong trade.

COWS & CALVES

Trade very buoyant for the cows & calves and leaner summering types with stronger calves to ± 1510 while Hereford x cows with 1mo calves reached ± 1230 . Leaner Hereford x cows running with Hereford bull (not PD'd) produced strong bidding to ± 1000 .

YOUNG CONTINENTAL

Young cattle particularly dear as plenty of buyers chasing the recent flush of grass. As expected at this time fewer well conformed suckled Continentals forward, however a good consignment from Andrew Gale commanded strong interest. His 9-10mo Limousin steers virtually all over £1100 topping at £1175 with heifers from the same good home at £1010. Sam & Gary Jenkins again saw their 14mo Charolais steers at £1405. Buyers wanting good conformation Dairy types saw smart 8mo Blue x steers from Suddon Grange to £820 and £745 with heifers at £625.

FRIESIAN/ NORMANDE/ NORWEGIAN RED

British Friesians stole the trade with 18-22mo steers selling well from £1000-£1145 and topping at £1180 from Sam Jenkins & family of Pewsey. Framed Holsteins also keenly bid to £1025 (29mo) from Stuart & Clifford Alvis of Radstock. Quality reared turn out steers a premium selling from £920 to £960 (16-17mo) all from Frost & Frost of Polsham and £865 (18mo) from GP Spiller of Queen Camel. Freemartin heifers also met fast bidding from £890 (21mo) to £990 (31mo) and topped at £1045 (32mo) all from HG Perkins & Sons of Radstock.

Nearly 100 on offer with named sires and farm assured at a premium. Forward steers sold well from £1200-£1300 (29-30mo) from Stuart and Clifford Alvis of Radstock, £1275 (only 17mo) from Sam Jenkins & family of Pewsey, £1200 from PW CC & JC Gould of Norton Ferris and £1155 from Frost & Frost of Polsham. Framed heifers met keen interest to £1145 (27mo) from PW CC & JC Gould and potential bullers sold from £815 (15mo) from Frost & Frost to £850 from VL Vincent & Son of Weymouth.

Yearling steers an electric trade selling to £1135 (13mo) from Robin Pocock of Calne and others to £900 from Frost & Frost; their yearling heifers also sold well to £815. Double muscled yearling heifers a premium selling to £980 (12mo) from Andrew Gale of Blandford and younger heifers also in demand with 7mo to £680 from PC Knowles of Claverham and £675 from RJ Phelps of Wells.

A good selection on offer met an outstanding trade with yearling steers selling from £1135 to a massive £1170 (all only 13mo) from Robin Pocock of Calne, £1040 (12mo) from PJ Wood of Stoke Wake and £960 from Suddon Grange Farm Ltd of Wincanton. Turnout steers also a premium from £1080 to £1200 (all 20mo) from MD & LM Keen of Melksham, £1198 (21mo) from Brian Trott of Castle Cary and framed steers to £1250 (27mo) from PW CC & JC Gould of Norton Ferris; their fleshed heifers met an amazing trade selling to £1390 (27mo) and other quality heifers sold to £1295, £1125 and £1098 (all 24-25mo) from RE & D Woodward of Norton Ferris.
