A roaring trade for Angus once again this week with the best pen of 4 sailing to £1488 from J Trott & Sons. Steers from Clive Baker to £1425 for 17mo. A good consignment of Angus from FJ Lessey & Son reached £1380. A super pen of 7 Angus from ML & RI Loder reached £1335 and £1232 from RH & AE Mayo. Younger, well grown for age, steers from PE King (Bristol) Ltd hit £1295 (13mo). Heifers with frame and cover to £1445 for a pair from IW Lane & Sons and £1288 from PH Creed & Son. Well grown heifers from RH & AE Mayo to £1252 and £1200 from FJ Lessey & Son. Younger suckler bred Angus from R Taylor & Sons to £1020 for 12mo and £1015 for 9mo from DR & EA Brimble.

HEREFORD & OTHER NATIVES

Closely followed at £1510 (only 21mo) from IW Lane & Sons of Norton Malreward, £1432 (21mo) from Steve Crossman of Horningsham and £1350 (21mo) from Rob & Wendy Lessey of Wincanton. Younger Blue steers sold to a strong premium with 17mo selling to £1440 from Clive Baker of Frome and 14mo to £1240 from PE King (Bristol) Ltd.

The good selection of younger Limousin also met an impressive trade with steers to £1260 (17mo) from PF Best & Son of Wareham and £1192 (17mo) from Robert & Jane Mayo of Weymouth. Similar Simmental steers wanted and sold to £1135 from Rob & Wendy Lessey.

Bulling potential Blue heifers also a premium selling to £1325 (only 19mo) from PH Creed of Somerton, £1235 (15mo) from PE King (Bristol) Ltd and £1120 from Rob Brice of Cheddar. Simmental bullers also keenly sought after to £1210 (19mo) from PF Best & Son and Limousin bullers to £1172 (19mo) from Robert & Jane Mayo.
