

Big numbers of Angus in this weeks sale saw the breed accounting for 50% of the total entry. Virtually all dairy bred and named sires for the younger section and more forward types today. Leaner younger summering types from DE Bridger £850 and £975 DB & BJ Hill. Heifers regularly £700 to £780 throughout the day. Stronger feeding steers & heifers had a tremendous day and were very much in demand. 22-26 month steers from PBT Jennings topped at £1390 and MW Hoskins £1385. S Hannaford saw his heifers equal the steers at a super £1390 and EAS Reeves at £1355. A wonderful consignment of 20 home bred grazing Angus x steers and heifers from John Hooper commanded premium bidding seeing steers often over £1250 with the best pen at £1360, while heifers topped at £1240! Angus buyers certainly showing plenty of confidence today.

HEREFORD & OTHER NATIVES

As we saw earlier in the week at Monday's orange market the demand for Hereford cattle increased considerably. Older thicker steers from PBT Jennings at £1560. - 7. Connect with local groups or organisations that may be relevant.
- 8. Recommend 'Farmwell' which contains a wealth of information and further links...FCN Farmwell website has a range of information to support farmers with BTB, this includes biosecurity measures, contingency planning, and information about further support available... including from the TB Advisory Service Https://farmwell.org.uk/tuberculosis tb/
- 9. DEFRA blog on gov.uk contains a lot of useful information too


