Although a typical seasonal harvest week in respect of numbers the trade was again at the highest levels. Generally, more buyers still wanting cattle than available which resulted in excellent prices. 6mo Dairy x Angus steers wanted to graze through the summer saw strong demand at £788 from PT Hinds. 10mo Angus heifers generally £600 - £660. Amazing young quality 13mo Dairy x Angus heifers again from PE King (Bristol) Ltd topped at £1075.

A number of Angus and Hereford forward stores were on offer and created furious bidding throughout. Plenty of 20 – 24mo steers over £1200, best sorts from EAS Reeves & Sons at £1355 and P & R Stranger & Sons at £1390. Thicker fleshed Angus heifers always £1150+ and superb deep bodied types from SC Eavis peaked at £1395. Some outstanding Dairy x Herefords coming through this week with forward steers again from the Stranger family selling to £1580 - £1295 who were just pipped to the post by Wayne Lenihan's steer at a blistering £1675. Mainly 18-20mo Hereford heifers on offer today and all sold to an advantage with some nice bulling sorts from AJ & GG Thomas selling to £1020. Overall, a great run of cattle in this section.
