

I was recently approached by a very concerned farmer from the Somerset levels that felt he was being unduly victimised by the Environment agency and felt their end aim was to force him out of farming This made headline in the SW Farmer paper? The local MP highlighted this issue, and discovered that others were the main culprits of pollution. The EA claim there is no hidden agenda to force Farmers off their land, and that they are committed to working with farmers to prevent pollution I had a chat with the farmers local NFU office...and they are well aware and have much sympathy with this situation on the levels
