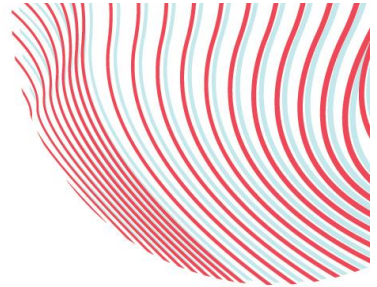

HEREFORD

What a trade with excellent bidding forcing prices beyond expectations. Well presented steers met fast bidding from £1390 to £1500 (22mo) all from The Late Mrs EA Coombes of Wells. Other quality steers sold well from £1200 to £1300 (22-24mo) from Jacob Mattick of Radstock and £1160 (21mo) from J Alvis of Gloucester. Forward yearling steers also a highlight selling to £1095 (14mo) from S James of Gillingham and younger dairy crosses to £820 (only 10mo) from Maurice & Rupert Loder of Yeovil. Only a few heifers on offer this week met and excellent trade with 25mo heifers selling to a massive £1390 for RF & S Godwin of Bath and 14mo heifers to £790 from S James.

ANGUS

A fantastic trade for Angus this week with the medium and longer term farming cattle dealer on the week driven by demand around the ring. Forward steers topped at £1635 for a super pair from CF & AM Martin. A cracking consignment of suckler-bred Angus from DJ Glover to £1600, £1420, £1368. Steers from RL & CJ Curtis sailed to £1588 for 19 months and £1440 for a single steer from KE & AM Rostigina. Heifers with shape and cover to £1445 from CF & AM Martin. Suckler-bred Angus heifers from DJ Glover £1395 and £1200 with

younger sorts to £1150. Medium-term cattle wanted to feed and graze with 17mo to £1280 from DP & EM Halliwell and others £1000 to £1200. Heifers £950 to £1180. Younger Angus dearer on the week with customers in attendance for harder grazing types and well-grown suckler-bred steers and heifers. Dairy x steers to £1005 from ML & RI Loder and younger harder jacketed Angus to £962 for 13mo from DB & BJ Hill & Sons. A pen of 4 steers from CJ & SR Yorke to £945 (15mo) and £885 (10mo) from RL & CJ Curtis and £850 from RI & CJ Loder (13mo). Younger steers again £785 (10mo) from E & M Searle and others £700+. Other well presented Blue Steers wanted and sold to £1230 (20mo) from GG & CJ Bicknell and Rouge Flamande steers to £1208 & £1200 (23mo) from Jacob Mattick of Radstock. Well grown turn out steers also in demand with Simmental steers to £1110 from CB Farms Ltd of Westbury and Blues at £1085 from Boris & Sarah Chick of Sherborne and £1032 (16mo) from S James of Gillingham. Heifers equally wanted with young fleshed Charolais heifers selling well to £1365 (only 16mo) from S & G Jenkins and their Blue heifers to £1268 (17-18mo). Fleshed Limousin heifers also met keen demand to £1340 (23mo) from J Alvis. Blue bullers keenly sought after selling to £1140 (20mo) from GG & CJ Bicknell and Limousin bullers to £1078 from CB Farm Ltd and £1020 from J Alvis.

We recommend selling early this year to take advantage of this strong trade.
