ORGANIC HEIFERS TO £1400

Strength in high demand again this week with the best forward Continental cattle to £1970 and natives to £1800 both from WD & VJ Masters who always present their cattle very well. Medium and longer term cattle still very much wanted with plenty of grass about and confidence in the trade. Stores averaged £1031 including some excellent consignments of Organic cattle.

ORGANIC

A cracking entry of close to 100 head in our August Organic sale. Trade was again excellent with more new Organic purchasers coming to Frome. A super consignment of 70 from Dan Tate of Manor Farm Dairy created strong interest throughout with 8-9mo Dairy x Blue steers at £775 and heifers to £790. Young Dairy x Angus 9-10mo were wanted to £835. Forward Fleckvieh steers, lean and ideal for feeding, topped at £1420; their older Angus x steers sold well to £1380 and top sorts 19mo from FA Wilcox & Son peaked at £1490. Angus x heifers from the same home topped at £1190. Top of the section overall on both steers and heifers went to RJ Dimond for his superb South Devons with 18mo steers to £1520 and 15mo heifers to £1400.

YOUNG CONTINENTAL

As expected at this time of year not many single suckled younger Continentals forward with the entry being mainly Dairy x today. The best Continentals coming from regular vendor RJ & A Boulton who saw their top grade 13 month Limousin steers to £1310, 15mo Limousin heifers from the same home at £1298! Several 7-8mo Dairy x forward and all were sold well. Blue x steers and heifers from Wareham Partners saw steers at £702 and best heifers at £810. KJ Osborne & Partners presenting quality Charolais x steers 8-10mo £750-£828. Heifers also keenly sought at £735-750. Not too many younger Simmentals forward, although good types from ART Meatyard & Son 11mo to £805, £818 and £780!

Herefords met fast bidding for both the stronger and the younger farming cattle. Forward steers from WD & VJ Masters peaked at £1800 for an excellently presented pair and £1778 for a pen of 4. Beef Shorthorns £1460 from J Wake, £1280 from D Harrison and £1200 from PC Coward. Heifers from PA & RJ Stranger & Sons £1355 and £1240. Medium-term Hereford steers £1050 to £1138 and Beef Shorthorns £1035 to £1135.

ANGUS

Good numbers of Angus x this week both in the younger and forward section. Leaner Dairy x 6-8mo regularly £680-£750 for steers and £600-£650 for heifers with consignments from Wareham Partners, Perry Farm Ltd and KJ Osborne & Partners.

Medium aged 14-15mo steers and heifers regularly £1000-£1150. Stronger forward Angus were again eagerly sought. 16mo steers presented by M Maggs easily sold at £1360 and £1345. Thick Angus heifers had excellent demand and K & EJ Simpson saw their heifers at tremendous levels £1465, £1445 & £1420!! Overall another great day in this section.
