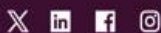

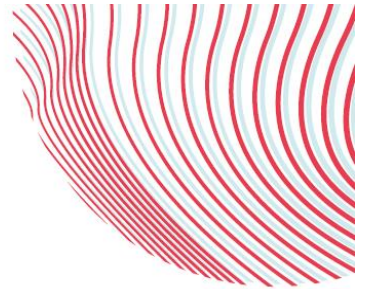

A super number of calves coming to Frome with over 200 penned for sale. Overall a good showing of quality types which was reflected in the prices achieved. Generally the very top calves continue to be the investment.

CONTINENTAL BULLS TO £350/ HEIFERS TO £280

Plenty of Continentals coming forward with over 35% of today's entry being British Blues. Some super well-shaped Blue bulls saw lively bidding, £282 from Jackson & Sons, £290 and £332 from C & P Milton and a real topper at £350 from Richard Durston. 17 Bulls over £200 this week with plenty of bulls £140 - £180. A good trade for Blue heifers throughout the sale and generally matched the bulls, many £140 - £170 and the best shaped types £180 - £235 and a grand heifer from PJLS Farms Ltd to £280. Simmental & Limousin in short supply but tidy bulls £180 - £185. Simmental & Limousin heifers were generally higher quality than the bulls. Two super Simmentals from Martin & Julian Carver peaked at £195. Outstanding Limousin heifers again from Richard Durston topped at £240.

NATIVE BULLS TO £315/ HEIFERS TO £315

Close to 100 Angus forward this week and all saw keen bidding throughout the sale. A few 8w/o types forward and nice bulls from J & W Davis peaked at a very respectable £315. Super younger fresh types from K & EJ Simpson seeing their Angus bulls over £200. A good compliment of strong bidders for the Angus heifers today. Older 8w/o again from the Davis family from £225 - £315. Many other well-presented Angus heifers £150 - £205 and were keenly sought. A good show of store cattle today with a few less forward and increased demand as buyers look to replace cattle sold. The strong beef price is reflected in the forward cattle and also giving confidence in longer-term stores. Some super consignments of forward stores and suckler bred stores as well as some genuine cow and calf outfits.

COWS & CALVES, IN CALF COWS & FEEDING BULLS

A marvellous day in this section with a number of super cows and calves on offer. First through the ring was the second consignment from C. Elliott, Swindon. Their Limousin cows with 5mo Limousin calves at foot met with blistering trade £2520, £2350. 20 topping sets from Tim Brown and family created furious bidding; all Blue x and Angus x Cows with quality Angus calves at foot these best sorts were 7 times over £2000 and 11 times over £1900. Blue x cows and Angus steers to £2350, best Hereford x cows and calves to £1860. Younger Charolais x first calf cow and 4mo heifer calf £1690. Overall a good trade through out.

YOUNG CONTINENTAL

Not quite the numbers of single sucklers forward this week but trade as fast as ever for these which came under the ring hammer. Quality homebred Charolais steers 6-7mo from Neil & Sharon Glover were wanted with bunches at £1045 & £1040. A wonderful consignment of suckled Limousin steers & heifers from LJ Vaughan had strong bidding regularly £1240-£1300 topping at £1305. Smart British Blue dairy x steers (13mo) from new vendor Scott Kingston produced keen competition to £905.

Well-grown and fed Angus steers from R & E Kingman & Son to £1580 and similar quality from MG Miller to £1500. Suckler-bred steers £1340 (18mo) from RF & J Horler and £1260 from J Wareham. Heifers from R & E Kingman & Son £1328 and £1175 and £1080 from IW Lane & Sons. Young steers from J Wareham £1140 (14mo) and £1100 (13mo). Longer-term wintering type Angus look slightly sharper on the week as buyers make room in shed.

HEREFORD & OTHER NATIVES

Overall a good trade but a few more cattle showing signs of the continued harsh weather. Well shaped and grown Hereford feeding steers always over £1250, with bunches from R & E Kingman & Sons, A Hammond, Mike Keen and Maurice Clacee £1285-£1450. Top spot to R & E Kingman & sons £1495! A few less strong Hereford heifers on offer but quality types from Mike Keen at £1235. Younger feeding Hereford steers and heifers (14-16 mo) perhaps a little harder to place £750 - £1050. A super consignment of Shorthorn from AG Hammond created excellent interest and their 17mo steers reached £1345 & dairy Shorthorn £1195. Heifers from the same home showed good strength and bone at £1082.

FRIESIAN & FLECKVIEH

Fast bidding for Friesians topping at £1288 for a pen of 5 forward steers from F & M Mouny & Sons. Steers with frame and potential £1188 from R & E Kingman & Sons and £1100 for OTM heifers for Hollands Farms Blandford to £1048. Fleckvieh steers from DW Hodges to £900 and £895 and Holstein Friesians at £770 (15mo).
