



A decent show of wintering store cattle forward today met fast bidding throughout and despite the wet weather, cattle of all sizes wanted.

#### **ORGANIC**

Close to 100 Organic penned for sale again for this month. A number of quality types were forward and trade lively although perhaps slightly steadier than 2 months ago as buyers have had to bring cattle in early due to the wet weather conditions and struggling for room. Childhay Organics saw their Blue steers and heifers (19mo) sell very well to £1450 and £1300 respectively. A wonderful entry from Hardwick Brothers of quality Angus and Hereford created excellent bidding. Their 18-19mo Angus steers topped at £1575 and regularly £1250 - £1400. Smart Angus heifers from the same home at £1345 while younger 16mo heifers sold to £1000. Tynings Farms (1987) Ltd again selling quality Hereford with their 20mo steers £1200 and heifers at £1265. Traditional Longhorn 29-30mo steers once again coming from Natural England, these quality types for the traditional meat market produced good interest £1175 - £1300 and the best pens at £1420.

#### **COWS & CALVES**

Only a handful on offer today but all sold well. Older cows and calves (9y/o) looked a good trade at £1020 as did the younger Hereford  $2^{nd}$  calved cows and 3mo calf at £1200. Grazing cows easily to £1050. Feeding bulls had a firm trade with 17mo Angus to £750.

#### YOUNG CONTINENTAL

Good demand for the suckled young Continentals once again at Frome. A wonderful annual consignment of 30 homebred quality Charolais steers and heifers from Rob & Julia Banwell created strong bidding with 6-8mo steers £900 - £1050 topping at £1070. Heifers from the same home had a storming trade with plenty over £800 and the best pen at £855. A good day for Charolais with Clive House seeing his smart steers (14mo) to £1055.

Dairy bred Blues from F Dening & Sons easily to £915. Best Blue heifers (12mo) from CJ & CJ Pople had an excellent day at £968. The very young plainer weathered cattle saw better competition than expected £450 - £550 and had 6mo Blues at £570.

Most of the strength was in the Organic Angus section. Suckler bred Angus steers with growth and shape to £1200 (17mo) from Clive House and the same price for DH Masters & Son. OTM heifers from S & H Webb £1290. Growing steers from Twyning Ash to £1190 and £1090 from F Dening & Son. Yearling Angus steers from CJ & CJ Pople to £1050.

#### **HEREFORD & OTHER NATIVES**

Demand remains strong for quality with Haydon Down Farm's steers selling to a massive £1365 (only 23mo). Younger steers equally in demand from £1115 to £1205 (18mo) from Ian Hale and £1010 from R Carter of Twyning Ash. 7mo steers also met keen demand to £690 from Houghton Farming. Heifers continue to sell well with framed heifers to £1050 (18mo) from Ian Hale and well presented bullers at £915 (18mo) from Ailsa Shields and £940 from R Carter of Twyning Ash.

#### FRIESIAN & FLECKVIEH

Only a few on offer but demand remains strong with British Friesian heifers selling well from £890 to £1190 (32mo) from KJ Withers, Clutton. Their British Friesian steers met keen bidding to £845 (17mo). Holstein steers also wanted to £760 (15mo) from Houghton Farming of Poole.
