But such instability and the impact it can have should make governments ever more reliant and emphasize the importance of **Home grown produce?** 84pc of the fruit we consume in UK is imported, and produce only half of the vegetables we need!Our retailers need 'encouraging' to mark up the country of origin on supermarket shelves....Our country's becoming more suitable for growing fruit and vegetables nowadays, that 20 years ago wouldn't have been possible!?
