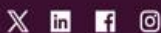

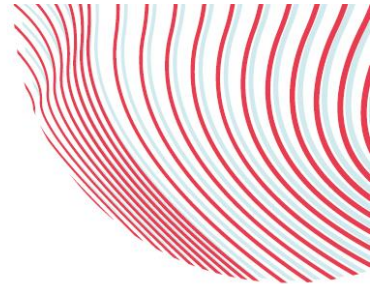

A roaring trade for store cattle which would be just as dear on the week driven by lack of supply and strong demand influenced by the rising finished beef price. Several cattle over the £2,000 mark again today topping at £2170 for Angus steers and £2020 for heifers. Some smart consignments of young continentals topping at £1405 for 10 months. Some genuine consignments of in-calf cows met competitive bidding resulting in all looking well sold. Store cattle averaged £1174. In calf cows averaged £1378.

ORGANIC

This week saw an extra organic sale with a super consignment of 65 Angus and South Devon organic in calf cows from E & AC Messenger reducing their herd. Trade was lively for these quality home bred types regularly over £1500 and topped at £1700! Buyers came from Oxford, Shropshire and Carmarthenshire as well as our local suckler breeders. Commercial in calf cows to £1390 with Hereford x heifer and young calf to £1380 overall an excellent day in this department.

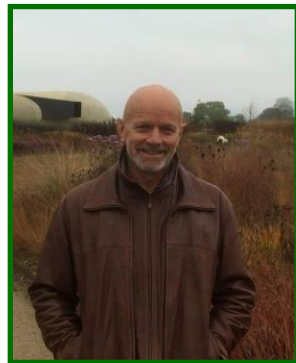
