## STORES (175) STEERS TO £2070 HEIFERS TO £1930

Our first TB orange market for 2025 got off to a flying start! A super entry of 175 stores produced trade just as bright as any weekly Friday Market. A good compliment of buyers were all vying to purchase these quality sorts.

#### CONTINENTAL

A number of quality Blues forward today ranging from 7 – 24mo. Strong well conformed steers 20-24mo were keenly fought for by the bidders seeing LP Shackell & Son to £1900 and RC Few & Son to £1690. Younger 15-16mo well-shaped Dairy bred Blue steers from Matthew Sawyer to £1390 - £1500. Well presented 7-8mo steers and heifers form GB Turner & Son were wanted at £885, heifers at £710 and 12mo steers from the same good home to an excellent £1260. Thicker Blue heifers were more scarce but well-shaped tidy sorts £1200 - £1500. Holstein Friesian as dear as all the other cattle topping at £1500 with non-breeding heifers at £1590 all from PJ Phillips & Son.

#### NATIVE

Traditional breeds continuing to see prices at premium levels and as the finish prices increase demand is quite staggering. Angus and Hereford made up 65% of this sales entries. Viv Doggrell & family saw their deep bodied Angus steers to £1950, closely followed by RJ Phillips & Son, RJ Hopkins and Martin & Paul Few all seeing steers to £1800, £1770 and £1700. Matthew Sawyer was well rewarded seeing his 14-16mo Angus steers at £1450. Angus heifers were equally sought with older types almost topping steers for this sale. Angus for Viv Doggrell produced top sorts at £1930 and £1900. Younger types from Martin & Paul Few and K & R Hickery to £1400 and £1590. It was an amazing entry from the Doggrell's as their strong deep bodied Herefords surpassed £2000 at £2070 and saw a new record at our Orange market for traditional breeds. Heifers from the same home at £1920. Very few 16mo+ animals under £1500 again this week.
