

BLUE TONGUE UPDATE

On Tuesday 21st January 2025 DEFRA announced the start of the 'Low Vector period' for Blue tongue meaning that midge activity is much lower due to a lower temperature. As a result, Blue Tongue movement restrictions have been changed to allow cattle and sheep to travel from inside the restricted zone to a Livestock Market outside of the restricted zone subject to a negative Blue Tongue test.

Cattle and Sheep can now come to Frome Livestock Market from a restricted zone providing they have been pre movement tested for Blue Tongue. Please contact your local vet to arrange a test. A general licence must also be obtained from DEFRA.



HEREFORD & OTHER NATIVES

Not quite the entry of Hereford as in recent weeks but trade was at tremendous levels. Wonderful strong forward steers from PJ Harvey saw exceptional bidding topping at £1900 and often over £1650. These were closely followed by CG Pulsford & Partners at £1500. Some good deep bodied thicker heifers on offer which saw W Green & Son and PW CC & JC Gould share top spot at £1600, not far behind were more grand heifers from CG Pulsford & Partners at £1565. Spring calving types wanted but in short supply this week.

FRIESIAN

Another strong day for the Friesian, Norwegian and Fleckvieh at Frome. As the finished weight ranges increase these good well framed types see ever increasing demand. Grand Fleckvieh 20mo steers from the Hares Partnership easily to £1690 while thicker British Friesian from the Gould family settled at £1390. Super large framed Holstein Friesians again this week from regular supporters CG Pulsford & Partners topped at £1500 at £1555. Younger 15mo Holstein Friesians were in keen demand at £990.

A substantial amount of Friesian heifers coming forward with almost all over £1100. HG Perkins & Son saw their 24-28mo consignment range £1475 - £1555. Younger 18-20mo bulling types from Dillington Farms Ltd from £1300 - £1395 and were very well sold.

FORWARD CONTINENTAL

Several super consignments of forward Continental cattle met with fierce competition and fast bidding as buyers look to refill yards. A cracking entry of suckler bred Charolais steers from PW Fry & Son with bone and shape topped at £2480 for a pair with others to £2020 and £2000. Charolais heifers from the same consignment £2090 and £1860. Fed Blue heifers from EL Norris & Son topped the heifer section at £2180. Limousin steers from PW CC & JC Gould to £1945. An excellent run of suckler bred Continental from Hares Partnership saw Simmental steers to £1750, Limousin steers at 16mo to £1725 and Blue steers to £1650. Limousin heifers from Hares Partnership to £1585 and £1365 for Limousin steers from WS Stitch.
