

Yearlings continue to sell to an astonishing trade with best presented steers selling from £1620 (15mo) to an outstanding £1800 (only 14mo) all from B & K Spreadbury of Calne and younger steers to £1000 from PH Creed of Barton St David. Their yearling heifers also selling well to £1205 (14mo) and closely followed at £1190 (15mo) from B & K Spreadbury.

HEREFORD & OTHER NATIVES





