BLUE TONGUE UPDATE WEDNESDAY 26TH MARCH

DEFRA have today announced a temporary easing of pre-movement testing for Blue tongue for non-breeding livestock leaving the restricted zone.

- Store stock can move out of the restricted zone without a premovement test but must still have specific licence EXD 632
- Only the following animals still require both a pre-movement test and a specific movement licence EXD 632: Calves under 60 days Breeding stock including breeding bulls, in-calf cows, cows with calves at foot and ewes with lambs at foot

This is a temporary change that will apply until 23rd April 2025




